Buxus 'Wintergreen' (Boxwood)	2-4', 3-5' spread, foliage more likely to keep green color in winter vs. other Boxwoods
Cephalotaxus harringtonia 'Prostrata' drupacea (Japanese Plum Yew)	2-3' height & spread, use as individual or mass
Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Nana Gracilis' (Dwarf Hinoki Cypress)	2-3', dwarf slow growing specimen
Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Kosteri' (Koster Hinoki Cypress)	4-5', semi-dwarf slow growing specimen
Ilex crenata 'Green Lustre' (Japanese Holly)	4', spread 5-8'
Ilex crenata 'Helleri' (Japanese Holly)	2', spread 4'
Ilex crenata 'Hoogendorn' (Japanese Holly)	1-2', spread 3-4'
Ilex crenata 'Soft Touch' (Japanese Holly)	2-3'
Ilex glabra 'Shamrock' (Inkberry)	3-5'
Ilex glabra 'Compacta' (Inkberry)	4-6'
Microbiota decussata (Russian Cypress)	1', 8-12' spread, can be considered a groundcover . Turns purple brown in winter
Microbiota decussata 'Celtic Pride'	1', 8-12' spread, can be considered a groundcover . Turns purple brown in winter
Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag' (Dwarf White Pine)	6-8', 8-10' dwarf slow growing specimen, native plant
Pinus strobus 'Nana' (Dwarf White Pine)	6-8', 8-10' dwarf slow growing specimen, native plant
Taxus baccata 'Repandens' (Yew)	2-3', 10-12' spread, can be considered a groundcover
Taxus x media 'Everlow' (Yew)	1-2', 4-6' spread, can be considered a groundcover
Taxus x media 'Greenwave' (Yew)	3-4', 5-6' spread, nice as individual or mass as groundcover

SHRUBS: Flowering evergreen part sun

Rhododendron 'Chionoides'	3-4', 4-5' spread, white with yellow center, late May bloom
Rhododendron 'Dora Amateis'	White with yellow splotch, 3-4' early May
Rhododendron x 'Ken Janeck'	3', pink white slow growing, mid May bloom
Rhododendron 'Molly Fordham'	White. 5'. Wide spread, early May
LAVENDER PINK/PURPLE	
Rhododendron 'Amy Cotta'	Lavender flowers, 2-3', mid May
Rhododendron 'Boursault'	6-8', late May bloom
Rhododendron 'Edith Bosley'	4-6', late May bloom, deep purple color
Rhododendron 'English Roseum'/'Roseum Elegans'	6-8', late May bloom, very common
Rhododendron 'PJM'	lavender flowers, 5-6' late April
Rhododendron 'PJM Elite'	lavender flowers, 5-6', latest blooming PJM early May
Rhododendron 'Scintillation'	4-5', late May bloom, no full sun, slightly more pink than lavender
Pieris x 'Brouwer's Beauty'	5', white flowers
Pieris japonica with white flowers and not much red new growth:	
Pieris japonica 'Cavatine'	Dwarf, 2-3', slow grower, white flowers
Pieris japonica 'Dorothy Wycoff'	4-5', pink to white flowers

Pieris japonica 'Sarabande'
Pieris japonica 'Scarlet O'Hara'

Dwarf, 2-3', slow grower, white flowers
6-8', slender upright form, red new growth, white flowers

Aronia melanocarpa 'Autumn Magic' (Black Chokeberry) 3-5', white spring flowers, black berries, fall color, native plant
Comptonia peregrina (Sweet Fern) Use in masses, 2-4', fern foliage fragrant when crushed, native plant
Forsythia 'Lynnwood Gold' 8-10'
Forsythia 'New Hampshire Gold' 5-6', purple fall color
Fothergilla gardenii 2-3', white flowers in spring, great fall color, native plant
Fothergilla gardenii 'Blue Shadow' 4-6', white flowers in spring, blue green leaves, great fall color, native plant
Fothergilla major 'Mount Airy' 5-6', white flowers in spring, great fall color, native plant
Hydrangea paniculata 'Little Lime' (Panicle Hydrangea) 4-6', lime green to white summer to pink fall flowers, fall color, arching form
Hydrangea quercifolia 'Pee Wee' (Oak Leaf Hydrangea) 2-4', 3-6' spread, white summer to pink fall flowers, fall color, native plant
Hydrangea quercifolia 'Munchkin' (Oak Leaf Hydrangea) 2-3', 3-5' spread, white summer to pink fall flowers, fall color, native plant
Hydrangea quercifolia 'Pee Wee' (Oak Leaf Hydrangea) 4-6', 6-8' spread, white summer to pink fall flowers, fall color, native plant
Itea virginica 'Henry's Garnet' (Virginia Sweetspire) 3-4', 6-8' spread, white spring flowers, great fall color, can take full shade, native plant
Itea virginica 'Little Henry' (Virginia Sweetspire) 3-4', white spring flowers, great fall color, can take full shade, native plant
Physocarpus opulifolius 'Diablo' (Ninebark) 4-8', burgundy leaves, pink white flowers mid summer, native plant
Physocarpus opulifolius 'Little Devil' (Ninebark) 3-4', burgundy leaves, pink white flowers mid summer, native plant
Physocarpus opulifolius 'Nugget' (Ninebark) 5-6', lime green yellow leaves, native plant
Physocarpus opulifolius 'Dart's Gold' (Ninebark) 4-5', lime green yellow leaves, native plant
Physocarpus opulifolius 'Summer Wine' (Ninebark) 4-6', burgundy leaves, pink white flowers mid summer, native plant

Rhus aromatica 'Gro-Low' 2-3', 6-8' spread, fall color, native plant, can be considered a groundcover
Vaccinium angustifolium (Low Bush Blueberry) 1-2', mass as groundcover, white spring flowers, edible berries, fall color, native plant
Viburnum burkwoodii 'Mohawk' 6-7', fragrant pink white May flowers, berries, fall color
Viburnum carlesii (Korean Spice Viburnum) 6-8', fragrant pink white May flowers, berries, fall color
Viburnum dentatum 'Autumn Jazz' (Arrowwood Viburnum) 6-10', white flower late spring, blue berries, fall color, native plant, may get a bit chewed by VLB
Viburnum dentatum 'Blue Muffin' 6-10', white flower late spring, blue berries, fall color, native plant, may get a bit chewed by VLB
Viburnum dentatum 'Chicago Lustre' 6-10', white flower late spring, blue berries, fall color, native plant, may get a bit chewed by VLB
Viburnum dilatatum 'Asian Beauty' 5', white spring flower, red berries, fall color
Viburnum dilatatum 'Cardinal Candy' 4-5', white spring flower, red berries, fall color
Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Popcorn' (Doublefile Viburnum) 6-8', white spring flowers, berries, fall color
Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Shasta' (Doublefile Viburnum) 6-10', white spring flowers, berries, fall color
Viburnum plicatum tomentosum 'Summer Snowflake' (Doublefile Viburnum) 6-10', white spring flowers, berries, fall color

PERENNIALS/GROUNDCOVER: part sun

Ajuga reptans (Bugleweed)	Deciduous groundcover , bronze green foliage, tiny blue flower
Actaea simplex 'Black Negligee' or 'Hillside Black Beauty' (Bugbane)	No full sun, 3-6', burgundy foliage, white bottle brush flower summer, native plant
Baptisia australis (False Indigo)	3-4', blue flower May/June, native plant
Convallaria majalis (Lily of the Valley)	No full sun, preading deciduous groundcover , fragrant white flowers May June
Coreopsis verticillata 'Zagreb'	1', yellow flower July/August, native plant
Dicentra eximia 'Alba' (Bleeding Heart)	No full sun, can be used as deciduous groundcover , white flower all summer, ferny foliage, native plant
Dicentra spectabilis 'Alba' (Showy Bleeding Heart)	No full sun, 2-3', white flower May June on arching stem, spring ephemeral so foilage dies back after bloom
Epimedium	No full sun, deciduous groundcover for dry shade, nice foliage
Euphorbia polychroma (Cushion Spurge)	1', yellow green flower and foliage
Geranium maculatum	No full sun, 1-2', nice foliage and lavender flower, native plant
Hakonechloa macra 'All Gold' or 'Aureola' (Hakone Grass)	No fun sun, 1-2', clumping grass with yellow green foliage
Helleborus 'Ivory Prince'	No full sun, 1-2', evergreen foliage, long bloom Fgreen flower eb-May
Hemerocallis 'Stella d'oro' (Daylily)	1', yellow, rebloomer, nice foliage
Heuchera americana	Green purple foliage, our native Heuchera, can mass as a groundcover
Heuchera 'Plum Pudding'	1-2', deep purple foliage
Hosta 'Blue Angel' or "Bressingham Blue"	No full sun, 2-3', 3-4' spread, blue leaves
Hosta 'Christmas Tree', 'Minuteman', 'Patriot'	No full sun, 2-3', 3-4' spread, green with white leaves
Hosta sieboldiana 'Elegans', 'Frances Williams'	No full sun, 2-3', 3-4' spread, blue green and green with yellow leaves
Iris siberica 'Caesar's Brother'	2-3', June dark blue purple bloom and sword like foliage
Iris siberica 'White Swirl'	2-3', June white bloom and sword like foliage
Lamiastrum galeobdolon (Yellow Archangel)	No full sun, groundcover , 1', yellow flowers June
Lamium maculatum (Dead Nettle)	No full sun, groundcover , lavender pink flowers
Nepeta x faassenii 'Walker's Low' (Catmint)	1-2', silver foliage, lavender flower April to Fall
Pachysandra terminalis	Evergreen groundcover , 1'
Pennisetum alopecuroides (Fountain Grass)	1-2', mounded grass with feathery plumes, prefers full sun
Rudbeckia fulgida 'Goldsturm' (Black Eyed Susan)	2-3', golden yellow flower July-frost, best flowering in full sun but takes light shade, native plant
Schizachyrium scoparium 'The Blues'	3' clumping blue grass, native plant, prefers sun
Vinca minor	Evergreen groundcover , 4", blue flowers in spring
Waldsteinia ternata (Barren Strawberry)	Deciduous groundcover , green leaf, yellow spring flower, tolerates dry shade

BULBS (plant in fall)

Narcissus, 'Ice Folly', 'Thalia' (Daffodil)	Thalia is creamy white, Ice Folly is white and yellow. Plant in large clumps or swaths.
Muscari armenica (Grape Hyacinth)	Looks great with daffodils, small purple
Scilla	Plant hundreds for blue woodland small flowers in spring
Galanthus (Snow Drops)	tiny white for mini garden. Plant many at a time.
Iris cristata (Dwarf Iris)	tiny Iris that can take shade, spring deep blue bloom
